# WEEK OF PRAYER & FASTING: Day 3 Castleton Community Church | Psalms of Wisdom

**Song: "10,000 REASONS"** 

PRAYER #1: PSALM 1

Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers;

<sup>2</sup> but his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.

<sup>3</sup> He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither.
In all that he does, he prospers.
<sup>4</sup> The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away.

<sup>5</sup> Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous; <sup>6</sup> for the LORD knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.

#### Suggested Prayer Points:

- Praise that blessedness is not deserved, it is a gift of God v. 1 (Eph. 2:8-9)
- That we would delight in God's Word and that we would be doers of His Word v.2 (James 1:22)
- That we would yield fruit for Christ drawing others to Him v. 3 (Luke 10:2)
- That we would keep on the path of the righteous and not turn back v.6 (Prov. 2:20; Gal. 4:9)

Song: "BUILD MY LIFE"

#### PRAYER #2: PSALM 49

- <sup>5</sup> Why should I fear in times of trouble, when the iniquity of those who cheat me surrounds me,
- 6 those who trust in their wealth and boast of the abundance of their riches?
- <sup>7</sup>Truly no man can ransom another, or give to God the price of his life,
- <sup>8</sup> for the ransom of their life is costly and can never suffice,
- that he should live on forever and never see the pit.
- <sup>10</sup> For he sees that even the wise die; the fool and the stupid alike must perish and leave their wealth to others.
- 11 Their graves are their homes forever, their dwelling places to all generations, though they called lands by their own names.
- <sup>12</sup> Man in his pomp will not remain; he is like the beasts that perish.
- <sup>13</sup> This is the path of those who have foolish confidence; yet after them people approve of their boasts. *Selah*
- 14 Like sheep they are appointed for Sheol; death shall be their shepherd,

and the upright shall rule over them in the morning.

Their form shall be consumed in Sheol, with no place to dwell.

- <sup>15</sup> But God will ransom my soul from the power of Sheol, for he will receive me. *Selah*
- <sup>16</sup> Be not afraid when a man becomes rich, when the glory of his house increases.
- <sup>17</sup> For when he dies he will carry nothing away; his glory will not go down after him.
- <sup>18</sup> For though, while he lives, he counts himself blessed —and though you get praise when you do well for yourself—
- 19 his soul will go to the generation of his fathers, who will never again see light.

### Suggested Prayer Points:

- Steadfast faith in Christ amid the evil days that are upon us v. 5 (1 Cor. 15:58)
- Thank God for Christ who redeemed us for Himself vv. 7-9 (1 Peter 2:9)
- That we would not trust in health & wealth that are subject to decay vv. 10-17 (1 Tim. 6:17)
- That we would seek the praise of God and not man v. 18 (John 3:30; 1 Peter 4:11)

# Song: "BE THOU MY VISION"

#### PRAYER #3: PSALM 73

- <sup>1</sup>Truly God is good to Israel, to those who are pure in heart.
- <sup>2</sup> But as for me, my feet had almost stumbled, my steps had nearly slipped.
- <sup>3</sup> For I was envious of the arrogant when I saw the prosperity of the wicked.
- <sup>13</sup> All in vain have I kept my heart clean and washed my hands in innocence.
- <sup>14</sup> For all the day long I have been stricken and rebuked every morning.
- 15 If I had said, "I will speak thus,"
   I would have betrayed the generation of your children.
- <sup>16</sup> But when I thought how to understand this, it seemed to me a wearisome task,
- <sup>17</sup> until I went into the sanctuary of God; then I discerned their end.
- <sup>21</sup> When my soul was embittered, when I was pricked in heart,
- <sup>22</sup>I was brutish and ignorant; I was like a beast toward you.
- <sup>23</sup> Nevertheless, I am continually with you; you hold my right hand.
- You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will receive me to glory.
- <sup>25</sup> Whom have I in heaven but you?

  And there is nothing on earth that I desire besides you.
- <sup>26</sup> My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.
- <sup>27</sup> For behold, those who are far from you shall perish; you put an end to everyone who is unfaithful to you.
- <sup>28</sup> But for me it is good to be near God; I have made the Lord GOD my refuge, that I may tell of all your works.

#### Suggested Prayer points:

- Repent of envy, self-pity and negative emotions that provoke us to anger and jealousy vv. 2-3 (1 John 2:15-17)
- For regaining a proper perspective and rediscovery of the joy of the Lord that we have in Christ Jesus v. 17 (1 John 3:1; Eph. 1:7-9)
- That we would not harbor bitterness against one another v. 21-22 (Heb. 12:14-16)
- Remember those within our church family in precarious health; that God would be their strength v. 26 (Phil. 4:12-13; James 5:13-15)

## Song: "ANCIENT OF DAYS"

#### PRAYER #4: PSALM 127

1 Unless the LORD builds the house, those who build it labor in vain.
Unless the LORD watches over the city, the watchman stays awake in vain.
2 It is in vain that you rise up early and go late to rest, eating the bread of anxious toil; for he gives to his beloved sleep.
3 Behold, children are a heritage from the LORD, the fruit of the womb a reward.
4 Like arrows in the hand of a warrior are the children of one's youth.
5 Blessed is the man who fills his quiver with them!
He shall not be put to shame

when he speaks with his enemies in the gate

## Suggested Prayer points:

- That we would build our house on the solid rock of Jesus Christ v. 1a (Matt. 7:24-25, Eph. 2:19-21)
- That the Lord would watch over our city and its leaders v. 1b (Romans 13:1-3)
- That we would be anxious for nothing, but prayerful in everything v. 2 (Matt. 6:34; Phil. 4:6)
- For God's blessing on our children vv. 3-5 (Matt. 19:14; Eph. 6:1,4)
