Memory Verse: Psalm 104:24a

Main Passage: Psalm 104:24, Psalm 119:160, Psalm 115:3

## **Big Ideas:**

- God is the absolute standard by which we measure reality. God's view on every subject is truth.
- Wisdom is knowledge with experience. God has all wisdom and therefore, perfect judgment over creation.
- God is sovereign. He rules over all and is in total control. He uses providence to show us He is sovereign. There is no luck or coincidence.

## **Daily Discussion Questions:**

- **Day 1**: Read about the life of Joseph in Genesis 37-41. Did some of the things that happened to Joseph seem "bad"? How did the end of the story prove God's sovereignty?
- **Day 2**: Is there something that happened to you that doesn't seem as if it will work out right? How can you trust God with that situation?
- **Day 3**: Read Proverbs 2:6 and James 1:5. God has some characteristics He chooses to share with people. How can a person become wise?
- **Day 4**: How do we know what God says is true? Does His truth change?
- **Day 5**: Make a list of things that worry you. At the top of the paper write "God is Sovereign Over..." to remind you of God's sovereignty.
