ATTRIBUTES OF GOD: TRUTH, WISDOM, SOVEREIGNTY

Big Idea: God is like nothing else. He is truth and wisdom. He has sovereignty over all things.

Key Passage: Psalm 104:24, Psalm 115:3, Psalm 119:160

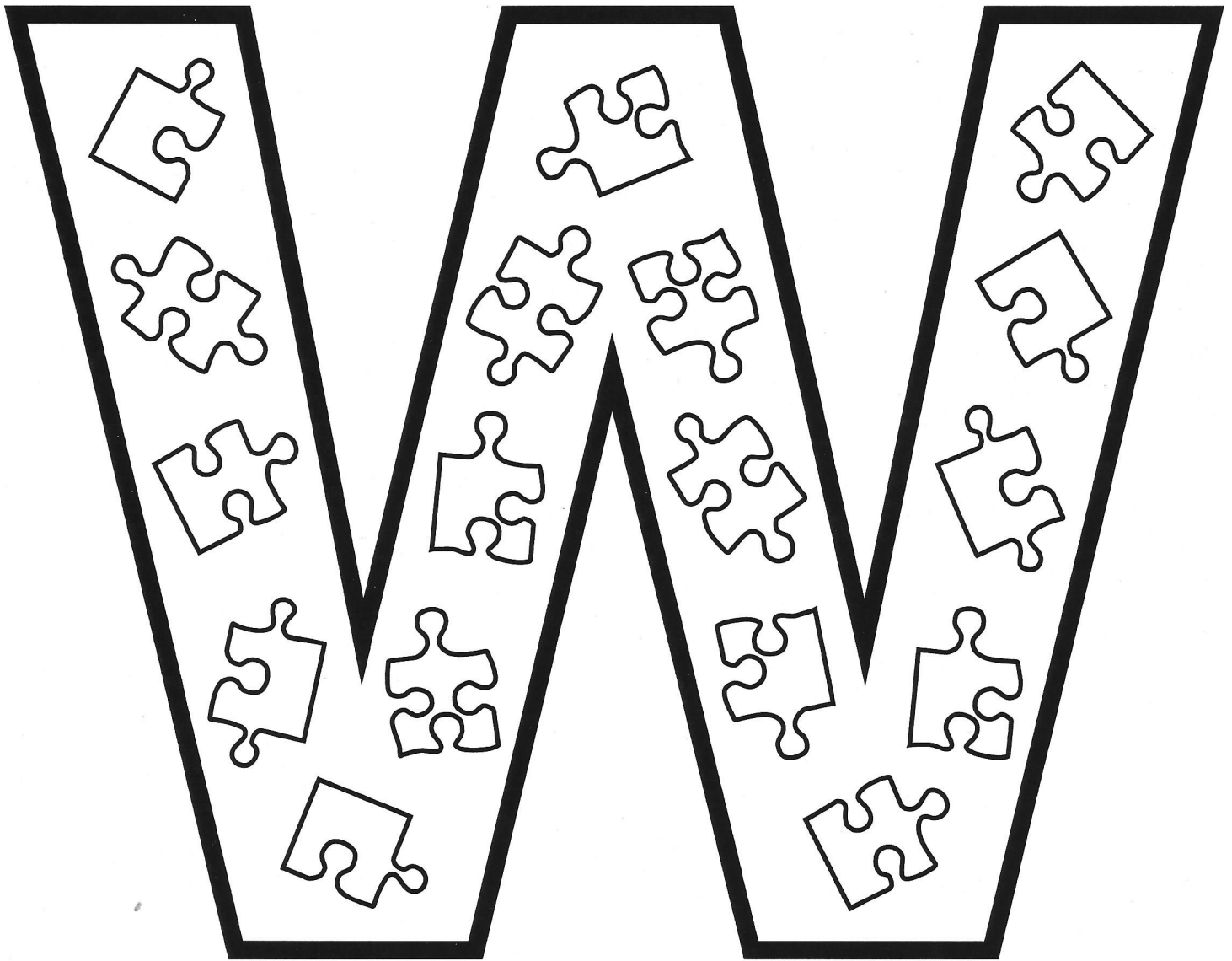
Big Picture Question and Answer: What is true about God? God is truth and all He says and does is truth. God is wise and He is sovereign over all things.

Family Discussion Starter: Another way to define "sovereign" is to say that God is the greatest authority of all. He is in charge. Why is it right that God is in charge of everything and everyone?

Family Activities:

- Work on a puzzle together. Talk about how each piece is a special part of the puzzle and how they all work together for a greater picture. Talk about how God works the things in our life this way.
- Find an interesting natural object like a pinecone or flower. Notice the ways God wisely made the object with all the detailed parts.
