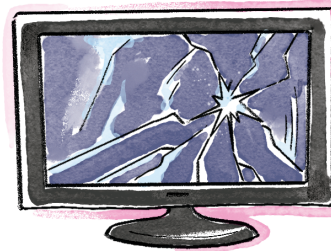
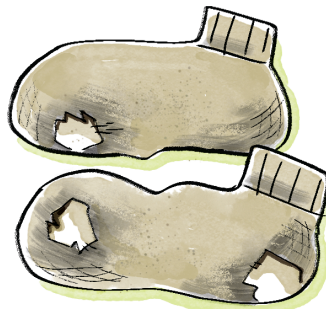
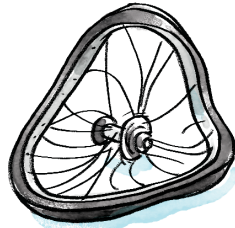


# Restore It

**BIG PICTURE QUESTION:**

**FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:**

- What does sin do to our relationships with God and other people?
- Who forgives our sin?

**FAMILY ACTIVITY:**

- Purchase an old, worn down item or article of clothing from a thrift store. Work with your kids to restore that item. Look up tutorials on the Internet to learn to polish shoes, patch clothing, or even re-stain wood. Talk about how God makes sinners new.

# David Sinned and was Restored

2 Samuel 11-12; Psalm 51

**Story Point:** David repented and God forgave Him.

**Big Picture Question:** How is Jesus the perfect King? Jesus perfectly rules over the universe as the King of Kings.

**Christ Connection:** When David sinned against God, God forgave him, but sin always come with a price. God spared David's life, but David's son died. When we sin, we deserve death. But we can receive God's forgiveness because God sent His Son, Jesus, to pay the price for sin.

**Key Passage:** Psalm 145:13

## Family Discussion Starters:

- Read Psalm 51 together. What parts of David's prayer stands out to you?
- Do you ever try to hide your sin? Why?
- How do you feel knowing Jesus died for your sin - past, present, and future?
