Hezekiah and Josiah

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Judah had mostly bad kings, but some were good.
- Hezekiah got rid of places people went to worship false gods.
- Josiah fixed up the temple and found the book of the law.
- Hezekiah and Josiah led the people back to God.

KEY PASSAGE: 2 Chronicles 7:14

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- How did God plan to fix what sin broke? Before He created the world, God planned to send the Messiah to save sinners.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Why didn't the people follow God forever after the good kings died?
- Who is our perfect King forever?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Work with your kids to plan different "King (or Queen) for a Day" events for each of them. Assign them different days on which they can make a few house rules that others will need to follow on that day. Talk about what it takes to be a good ruler and what makes Jesus our perfect King.

Hezekiah and Josiah

2 Chronicles 29; 34–35

Story Point: Hezekiah and Josiah led the people back to God.

Big Picture Question: How did God plan to fix what sin broke? Before He created the world, God planned to send the Messiah to save sinners.

Christ Connection: Hezekiah and Josiah loved God and wanted to follow His commands. They wanted God's people to love God and obey the law too. When Jesus came to earth, He fulfilled the law by obeying it perfectly.

Key Passage: 2 Chronicles 7:14
