BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Judah had mostly bad kings, and the people continued disobeying God.
- God sent many prophets to warn the people and tell them to follow God.
- Judah ignored God's prophets and was captured.

KEY PASSAGE: 2 Chronicles 7:14

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- How did God plan to fix what sin broke? Before He created the world, God planned to send the Messiah to save sinners.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- How is God loving to punish sin?
- Did God abandon His people when they were captured? Why or why not?
- Who took our punishment for us?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Organize a game of capture the flag with your family and any friends your kids want to invite over. Talk about how we are born as slaves to sin, but Jesus died to set us free from sin so that we can love and obey God.



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Judah Taken Captive

2 Chronicles 36

Story Point: Judah ignored God's prophets and was captured.

Big Picture Question: How did God plan to fix what sin broke? Before He created the world, God planned to send the Messiah to save sinners.

Christ Connection: God was right to punish His people for their sin, but He kept His promise to provide a king through David's family. Ultimately, God punished our sin through His Son, Jesus, and made Him our King forever.

Key Passage: 2 Chronicles 7:14
